**Petro Sabluk**, Doctor of Science (Economics), professor

In 1974 received PhD degree protecting the PhD Thesis “Organization and efficiency of operative analysis of stock-raising in the conditions of intersectorial transfers (on the example of collective farms of the Chernovickaya area)”.

In 1990 received Doctor’s degree protecting the Doctor’s Thesis “Account, control and analysis in agrarian sector management (methodology and organization)”.

Petro Sabluk is one of founders of new methodology of pricing, adjusting of intersectorial economic relations in agroindustrial complex, and also methods of land money estimation and assets of

production. Many-sided scientific interest of P.T. Sabluk engulfs development of theoretical bases of agriculture transformation to the market economy, forming of new model of its organization on principles of collective and private property, creation of high-autonomous subsections in an economic relation inside of the economies and new legal forms of management which are based on private basis. He offered the non-standard mechanism of purchase and sale of the land, grounded on the necessity of including of the land to market relations as a component of capital. Considerable are his achievements in practical realization of native alteration of legal forms of management, socio-economic and land relations on a village.

By the result of researches published over 630 scientific labours, 190 from them are monographs, brochures and reference books.

Petro Sabluk formed modern scientific school of economists-squirearchies of radical character. Under his guidance 18 persons protected the PhD Thesis and 29 persons protected the Doctor's Thesis.

Today he acts as the Director of the Institute of agrarian economy.



Andrzej Kowalski, professor, PhD hab. Graduate of the Central School of Planning and Statistics, Faculty of Production Economics, major – Agriculture Economics. He achieved the degree of professor in 2008. Habilitation in 1998, thesis title: *Spoleczne uwarunkowania rozwoju wsi i rolnictwa* ["Social conditions of rural areas and agriculture development"], PhD in 1983, thesis title: *Zabezpieczenie rolników na starość a gospodarowanie ziemią rolniczą* ["Old age insurance for farmers vs. agricultural land management"]. Specialisation: agricultural policy, social policy in the face of rural areas and agriculture, finance in agribusiness, structural transformations in agribusiness, foreign trade of agri-food products, economic transformation in agribusiness.

Today he acts as the Director of the Institute of Agricultural and Food Economics in Warsaw and Head of the Department of Rural Areas Development in SGH (Warsaw School of Economics, former Central School of Planning and Statistics). OECD expert (1992-1994), advisor and expert in the Ministry of Agriculture and Food Economy (1991-1993), member of a scientific council in the *Fundacja na Rzecz powołania Warszawskiej Gieldy Towarowej* [Foundation for establishing the Warsaw Commodity Exchange] (1994-1995), co-author of the concept and act on establishing ARMA, member and chairman in the management boards of agribusiness companies, member of a scientific council in Agrobiznes Club, member of the SAPARD

National Steering Committee, author of many expertises on agricultural practices, *inter alia*, for the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development, Agricultural Market Agency, ARMA, Agricultural Property of the State Treasury, UKIE, which concerned, *inter alia*, economic and social effects of structural changes, impact of the integration with the EU on development processes in Polish agriculture and rural areas, etc., Honorary Agribusinessman of 2003.
